

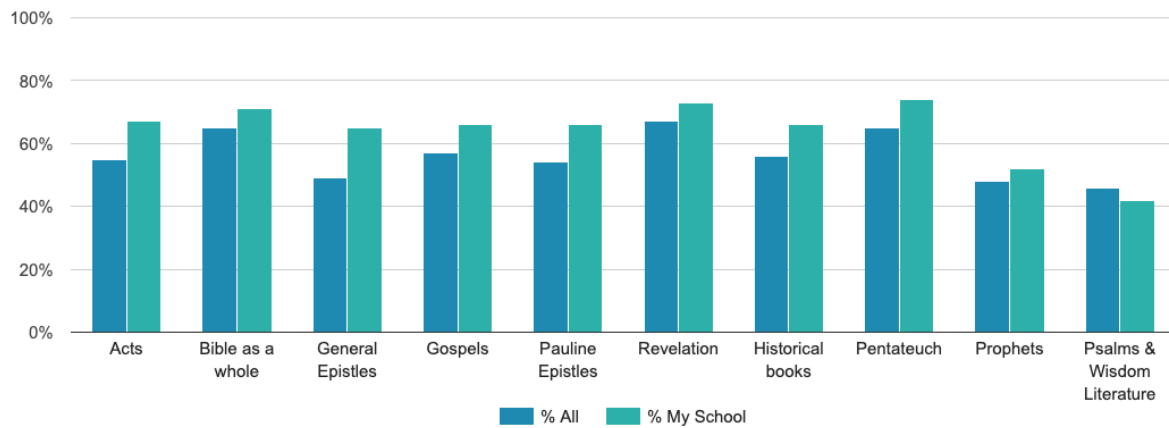
Bible Knowledge Assessment

The ABHE Bible Exam is administered to all incoming students in their first semester (College Study Skills course) and to all graduating bachelor students in their final semester (Senior Seminar course). The exam is comprised of 125 multiple-choice questions. The following charts are produced by Classic Learning Test (CLT) Exams based on the exam content and the student categories. Simple observations were provided by the Provost.

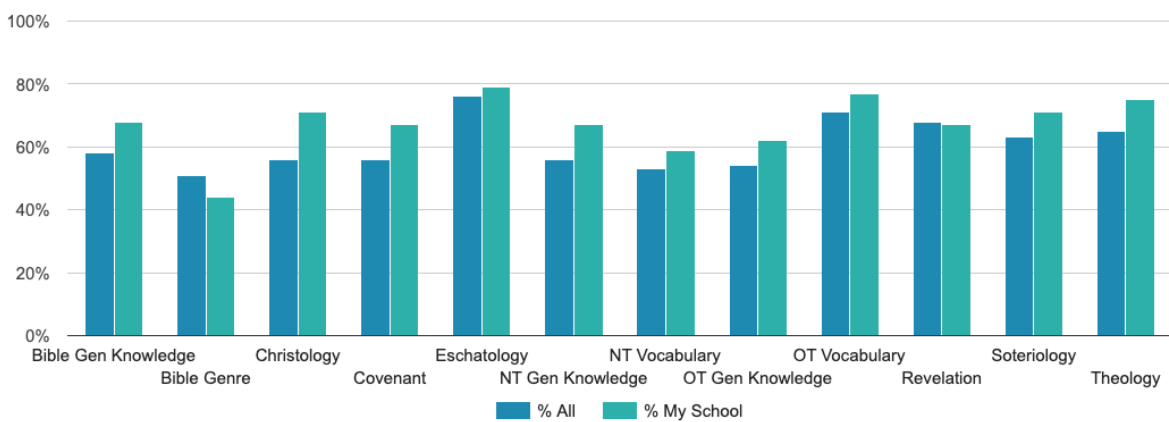
Performance by Category



Observation:

Overall, CCBS scored higher than the average of all other ABHE institutions in all areas except Psalms & Wisdom Literature.

Performance by Biblical Teaching



Observation:

Overall, CCBS scored higher than the average of all other ABHE institutions in all areas except (1) Bible Genre and (2) Revelation.

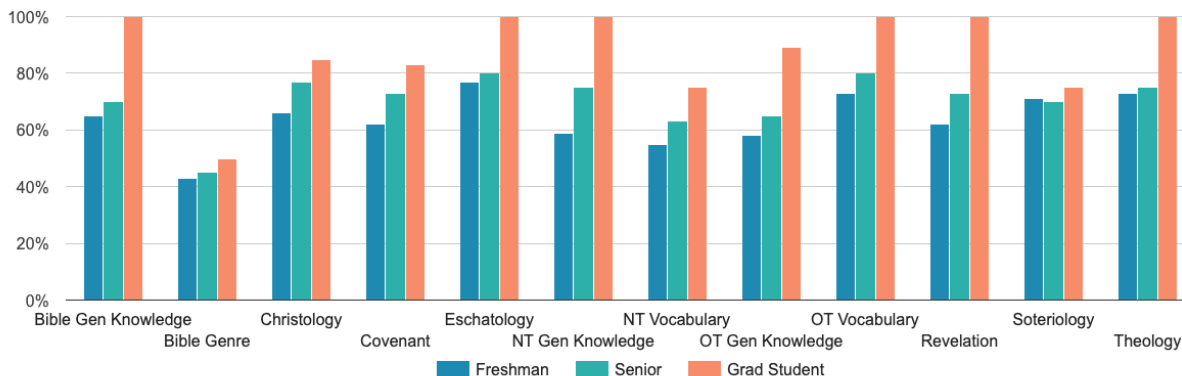
Performance by Category by Class



Observation:

This chart suggests consistent growth from the freshmen level to the senior level through ultimately the graduate student. The performance of the graduate student is significantly higher. In many cases, the senior significantly outperforms the freshmen. However, in General Epistles and Psalms & Wisdom Literature, the two classes were similar.
